<b>Funding</b>	£8000 +£5 per child DFE Government funding for Primary School PE development (£7000 to Hemsworth and rest to Primary Schools) Split into 3 parts: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. £5,500 = 1 Year salary for PE Specialist to help improve quality &amp; provision of PE</li> <li>2. £1,500 = Central pot of funding given to Hemsworth from the 8 cluster schools for resources, transport, facilities, equipment etc.</li> <li>3. £1,250approx. (£1000 + £5 per child) for each individual school for CPD, specialist equipment etc.</li> </ol>
