Our Uniform from Foundation Stage to Year 5

- Red cardigan or jumper with the Academy logo embroidered on the front (purchased from the school office, Tesco Online or Waterson Clothing in Hemsworth). Your first one is provided by the Academy.
- White polo shirt (ones with the Academy logo embroidered on the front can be purchased if you wish)
- Charcoal Grey trousers, skirt or pinafore
- Red gingham summer dress
- Black shoes

Our Uniform for Year 6

- Royal Blue Academy blazer with the Academy Logo embroidered on the front (this is provided by Wakefield City Academy Trust)
- White shirt
- Academy tie (this is provided by Wakefield City Academy Trust)
- Charcoal grey trousers or skirt
- Black shoes.

PE Kit

PE kit consists of black shorts and a white t-shirt.

Jewellery
